# Interpretation of Standard

#### **Achievement Criteria**

**Achievement** – Develop a proposal for a digital outcome

We have focused on helping learners understand how to develop a proposal that includes the proposed outcome statement, as well as the requirements, end users, and resources required for the outcome.

Achievement with Merit – Develop an informed proposal for a digital outcome

The focus here is on how feedback and research can be used to improve the proposal the learner has developed, as well as how the learner can ensure their proposal shows clear links between the requirements, end users, and resources required for the outcome.

**Achievement with Excellence** – Develop an effective proposal for a digital outcome

The focus for Excellence is on teaching learners how they can justify, by providing evidence, that their proposal meets the overall requirements of the outcome development project.
